Białystok and Supraśl





Białystok – the capital of the province, with the splendid Branicki Palace. A multicultural and multinational city where Esperanto language was created and where people of different faiths mix side by side. While Supraśl is another charming Podlasie town located on the edge of the Knyszyn Forest. Supraśl is home to secluded places with wooden houses, churches, a monastery and chapels. It is also a beautiful charming valley of the Supraśl River with rich flora and fauna of the Knyszyn Forest. Particularly noteworthy are the unique gothic defensive Orthodox Church of the Annunciation of the Holy Mother of God, the Icon Museum located on the grounds of the Archimandrite's Palace monastery, and the Buchholtz Palace, which dates back to the 19th century.

The tour includes:

- A walk around the Supraśl (Bucholtz Palace, weavers' houses, the Holy Trinity Church, the Town Hall, the Spa Park
- Wuseum of Icons click to see a virtual tour through the museum
- Supraśl Lavra visit to one of the oldest Orthodox male monasteries where a reconstruction of a unique 16th century defensive church with beautiful frescoes and St. John's Orthodox Church are located.
