Tykocin is the oldest and one of the most beautiful towns in Podlasie, called the "Pearl of Baroque" because of its architecture.

It's also a charming town with cobblestone streets, wooden cottages, lots of historical monuments and true Podlasie hospitality. Tykocin enchants from the first sight. This town is more than 6 centuries old, and its lands were ruled by the same powerful families like the Czarneckis and the Branickis. It was also here in Tykocin's castle that King August II the Strong established the Order of the White Eagle, the oldest state decoration. Moreover, to this day we can also easily notice the distinct division of the town into two parts, Catholic and Jewish.

The trip includes:

- Historic urban layout of the market square with the monument to Hetman Czarniecki, Holy Trinity Church, alumnate
- Synagogue and Talmudic house entry
- Reconstruction of the royal castle
- A walk along the Narew boulevards
